## Directions

#### Heading West on Route 38

Go West on Route 38. Make a right onto Hartford Road. Go through one light then make a right at the second light onto Centerton Road. The entrance to the parking lot is about one third of a mile on the right.

#### **Heading East on Route 38**


Go East on Route 38. Take the jug handle for Hartford Road to make a left. Go through one light then make a right at the second right onto Centerton Road. The entrance to the parking lot is about one third of a mile on the right.

#### **Heading South on Route 295**

Take I-295 South to Exit 43B toward Delran. Merge onto Creek Road. Make a left at the light onto Centerton Road. The entrance to the parking lot is about one mile on the left.

#### **Heading North on Route 295**

Take I-295 North to Exit 40A toward Mount Holly/Route 38 East. Merge onto 38 East. Take the next jug handle for Briggs Road to make a left. Make a right at the next light onto Marne Highway/Route 537. Make a left at the next light onto Hartford Road. Make a right at the next light onto Centerton Road. The entrance to the parking lot is about one third of a mile on the right.
