OUR RESPONSIBILITIES & DUTIES

To Provide Information

- Serve as a conduit between non-profit agencies and local farmers;
- Serve as an agricultural clearinghouse by creating an informational website and map of local farms;
- Chart land use in Guilford to support a balance between agriculture and preservation and other land uses.

To Promote Education

- Recommend necessary changes to language and practices across town departments and other boards and commissions as necessary regarding a local definition for agriculture, farming and farms;
- Educate town government about agricultural laws, such Right to Farm, and legal issues regarding farm machines;
- Provide information and guidance on agriculture-related zoning issues to town departments and other boards and commissions as necessary;
- Provide opportunities to support young farmers and new farmers, such as the Farmer-to-Farmer program, Landlink, and other mentoring programs;
- Support local, regional, and state vocational agriculture education programs.

To Enable Conflict Resolution

• Serve in an advisory and/or conflict resolution capacity to residents, established town committees and departments.

To Facilitate Economic Opportunities

- Identify innovative opportunities for farming additional lands in Guilford;
- Promote opportunities for residents and local businesses to support and value farming;
- Serve as a conduit between non-profit agencies, funders, and local farmers;
- Create a climate that supports the economic viability of farming as a career in Guilford.
