A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Article 3 of Chapter 12 of Title 2 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 2 relating to soil amendments, so as to prohibit application of soil amendments for any purpose
- 3 other than to foster the growth of a crop; to provide for certain exceptions; to provide for
- 4 related rules and regulations; to authorize concurrent local enforcement of laws, rules, and
- 5 regulations related to soil amendments; to provide for penalties; to provide for construction;
- 6 to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

8 SECTION 1.

- 9 Article 3 of Chapter 12 of Title 2 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to soil
- amendments is amended by revising Code Section 2-12-79, relating to prohibited acts, as
- 11 follows:
- 12 "2-12-79.
- 13 It shall be a violation of this article for any person to:
- 14 (1) Distribute an unregistered soil amendment;
- 15 (2) Distribute an unlabeled soil amendment;
- 16 (3) Distribute a misbranded soil amendment;

- 17 (4) Distribute an adulterated soil amendment;
- 18 (5) Fail to comply with a stop sale, use, or removal order; or
- 19 (6) Fail to submit semiannual reports; or
- 20 (7) Apply a soil amendment for any purpose other than to foster the growth of a crop,
- 21 <u>unless the soil amendment is:</u>
- 22 (A) Unadulterated;
- 23 (B) Free of any substance or material that has a propensity to generate a significant
- 24 <u>odor; and</u>
- 25 (C) Applied in compliance with applicable rules and regulations pertaining to
- 26 <u>maximum rate and frequency of application.</u>"

27 SECTION 2.

- 28 Said article is further amended by revising Code Section 2-12-80, relating to promulgation
- and adoption of rules and regulations and sharing of information, as follows:
- 30 "2-12-80.
- 31 The Commissioner is authorized to:
- 32 (1) Promulgate and adopt:
- 33 (A) Such rules and regulations as may be necessary to enforce this article. Such
- regulations may relate to, but shall not be limited to, methods of inspection and
- examination, designation of ingredients, identification of substances or materials that
- have a propensity to generate a significant odor, maximum application rates and
- frequency, and identity of products; and
- 38 (B) Rules and regulations relative to soil amendments derived from industrial
- by-products which may include, but not be limited to, application rates, proper
- 40 conditions for application, application record keeping and retention, use of site-specific
- 41 nutrient management plans, and storage and containment in or on lands where soil
- 42 amendments are applied, but shall exclude forest products, soil amendments derived

from industrial by-products generated solely from forest products, excluding chemical by-products of pulp digestion, slates, clays, shells, gypsum, and lime; provided, however, that pursuant to Code Section 2-1-6, no local government shall be prohibited or impaired from adopting or enforcing any zoning ordinance, including the adoption of buffers and setbacks; provided, further, that no such buffer or setback shall exceed 100 feet in width; and

- (C) Rules and regulations that require every owner and operator of a farm on which soil amendments are being applied to procure a site-specific nutrient management plan and make a copy of such plan available for inspection at the request of the department; and
- 53 (2) Share such information and consult with other agencies such as, but not limited to, 54 the Environmental Protection Division of the Department of Natural Resources and the 55 United States Department of Agriculture's Natural Resources Conservation Service."

SECTION 3.

- 57 Said article is further amended by revising Code Section 2-12-83, relating to penalties, as 58 follows:
- 59 "2-12-83.

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- 60 (a) Except as otherwise provided in this Code section, any person violating any provision
- of this article or regulation adopted under this article shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.
- 62 (b) Except as otherwise provided in this Code section, any person violating any provision
- of this article or regulation adopted under this article shall be liable for a civil penalty of
- 64 not more than \$5,000.00 per violation.
- 65 (b)(c) Any person who distributes or applies a soil amendment which contains domestic
- septage as such term is defined in 40 CFR 503.9 shall be guilty of a misdemeanor for the
- 67 first offense. For the second or any subsequent offense, any person who distributes or
- applies a soil amendment which contains domestic septage as such term is defined in 40

69 CFR 503.9 shall be guilty of a misdemeanor of a high and aggravated nature and, upon 70 conviction, shall be punished as provided in Code Section 17-10-4. Each such violation 71 shall constitute a separate offense. 72 (c)(d) Any person who distributes or applies a soil amendment which contains domestic septage as such term is defined in 40 CFR 503.9 shall be liable for a civil penalty of not 73 more than \$25,000.00 per violation. For the second or any subsequent offense, any person 74 75 who distributes or applies a soil amendment which contains domestic septage as such term 76 is defined in 40 CFR 503.9 shall be liable for a civil penalty of not more than \$50,000.00

77 per violation."

78 SECTION 4.

79 Said article is further amended by adding a new Code section to read as follows:

80 "<u>2-12-84.</u>

- 81 Notwithstanding the provisions of Code Section 2-1-6 or any other provision of this title:
- 82 (1) Counties, municipalities, and consolidated governments shall, together with the
- 83 Commissioner, have concurrent jurisdiction with regard to the enforcement of the
- provisions of this article and any rules and regulations promulgated pursuant to this
- 85 article;
- 86 (2) Counties, municipalities, and consolidated governments shall have the authority,
- acting separately or jointly with other such local governments, to employ persons to
- 88 investigate and enforce the provisions of this article and any rules and regulations
- 89 promulgated pursuant to this article; and
- 90 (3) Such persons employed for investigation and enforcement purposes pursuant to
- paragraph (2) of this Code section shall also have the authority to request and receive
- 92 assistance from the department in the enforcement of the provisions of this article and any
- 93 rules and regulations promulgated pursuant to this article."

94 **SECTION 5.**

All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed. 95
