

Nebraska Beginning Farmer Tax Credit Survey Results

In 2022 [Indiana University Food and Agrarian Systems](#) conducted a survey of participants in Beginning Farmer Tax Credits (BFTC) around the country.

A total of 50 beginning farmers and 100 landowners or “asset owners” who have enrolled in the Nebraska BFTC filled out the survey.

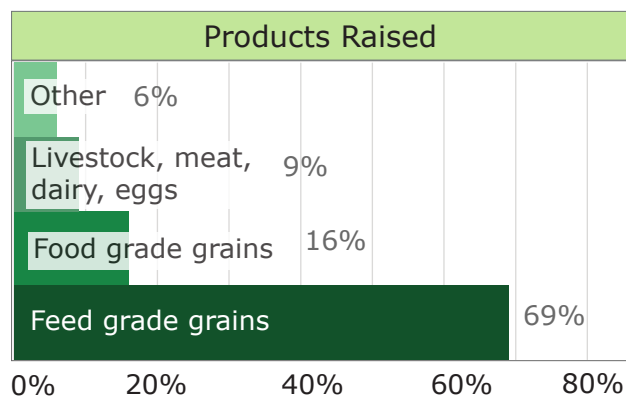
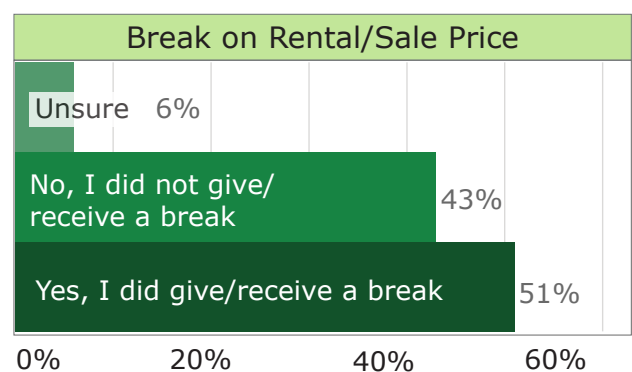

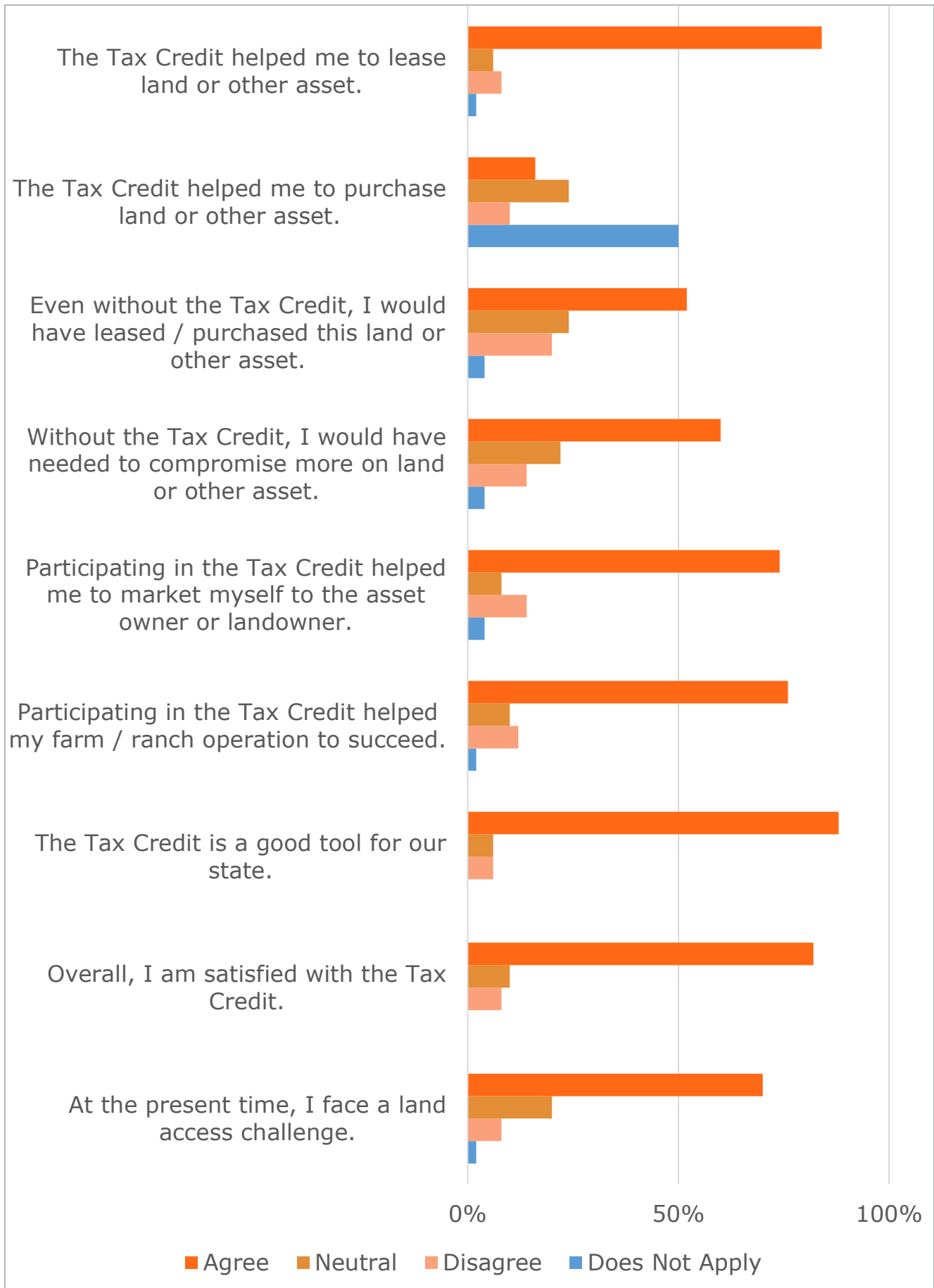
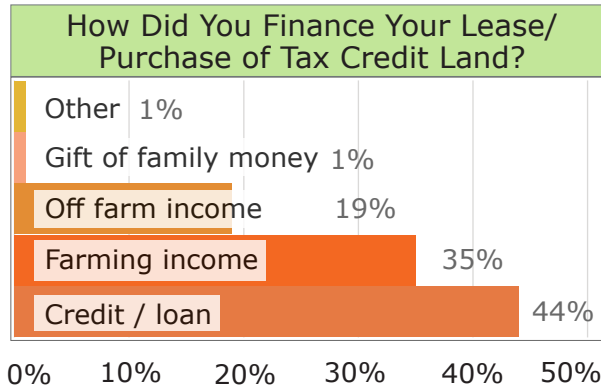
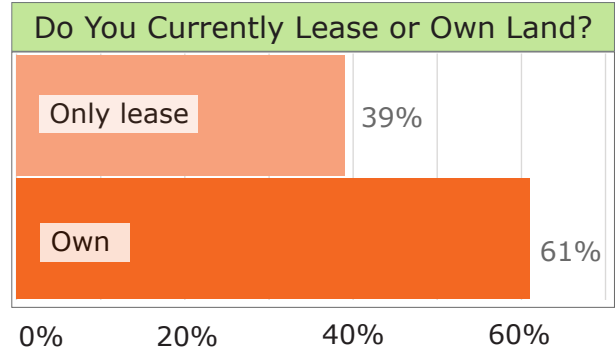
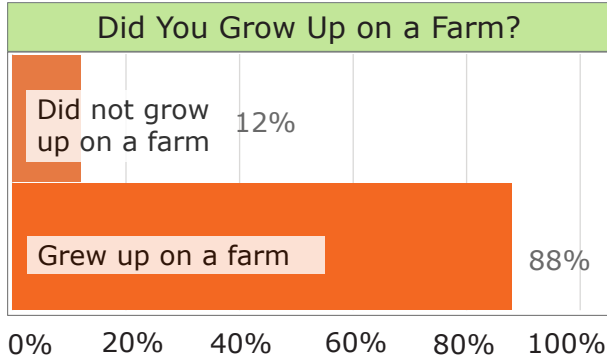

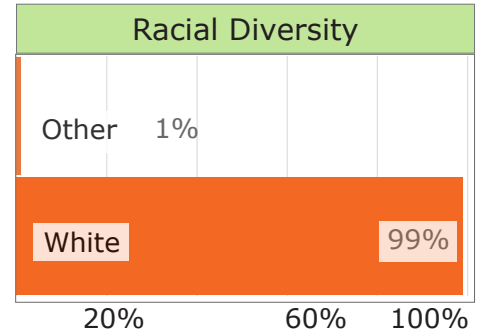
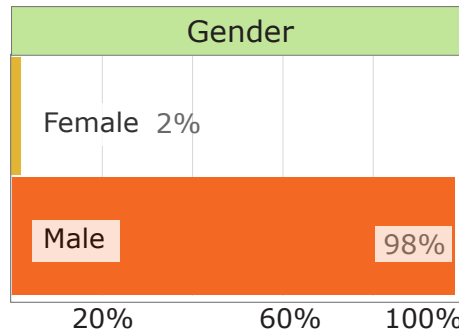
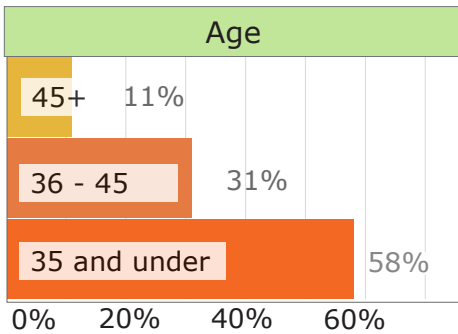
Beginning Farmer and Rancher Perspectives Since Participating in the Tax Credit



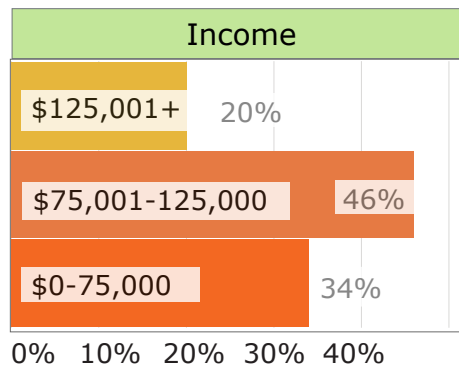
Beginning Farmer and Rancher Survey Responses



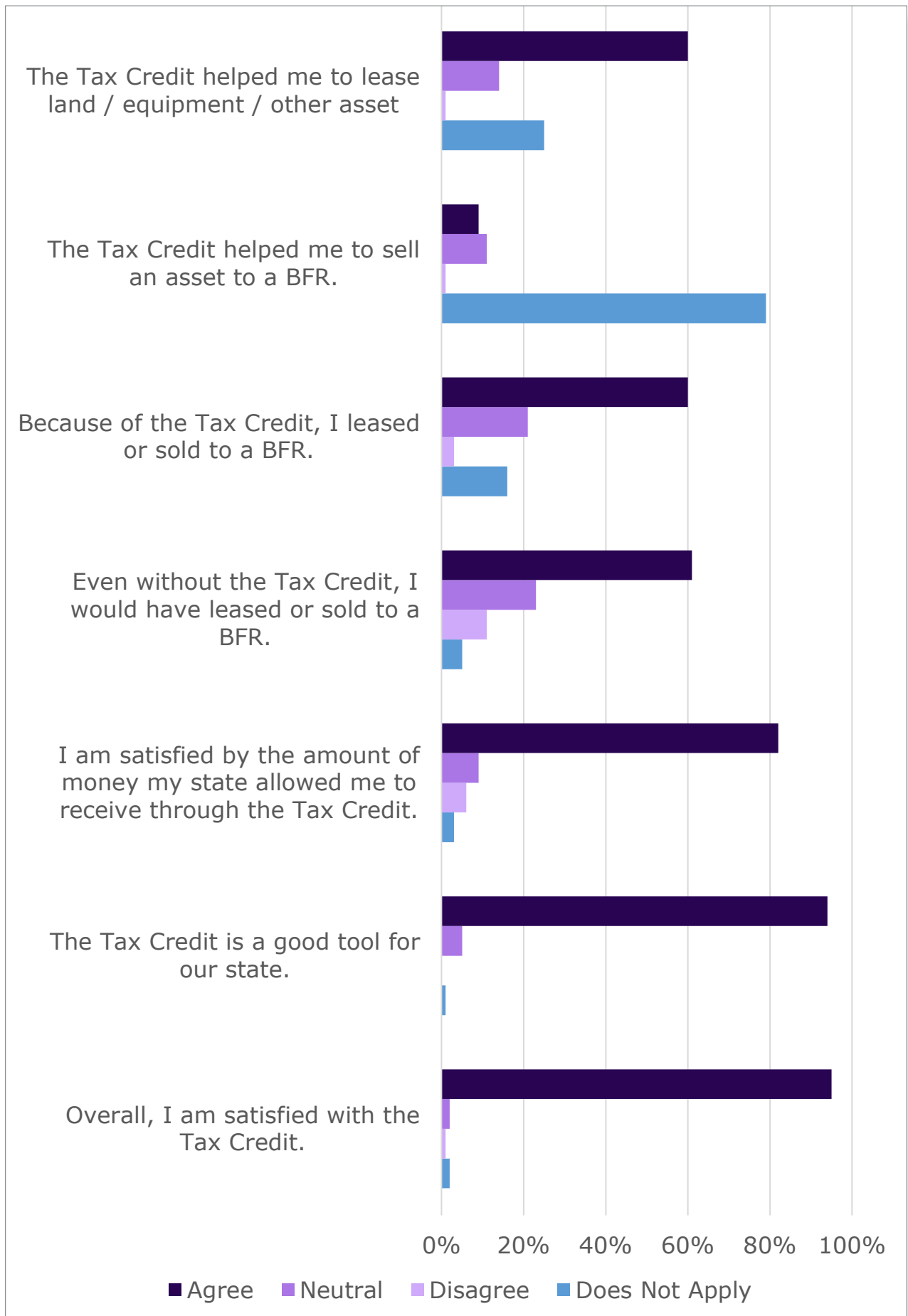
Demographics of Beginning Farmer and Rancher Survey Respondents

Asset Owner Survey Responses

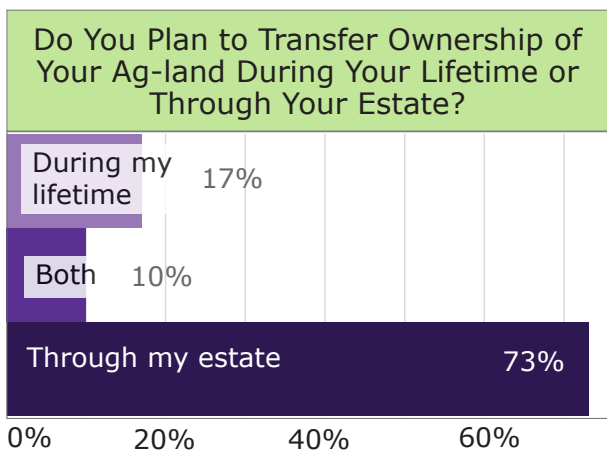
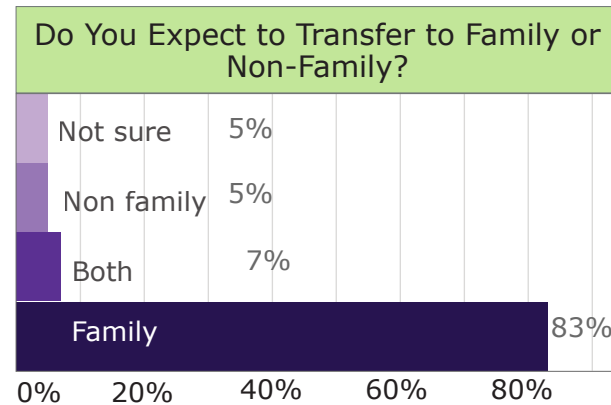
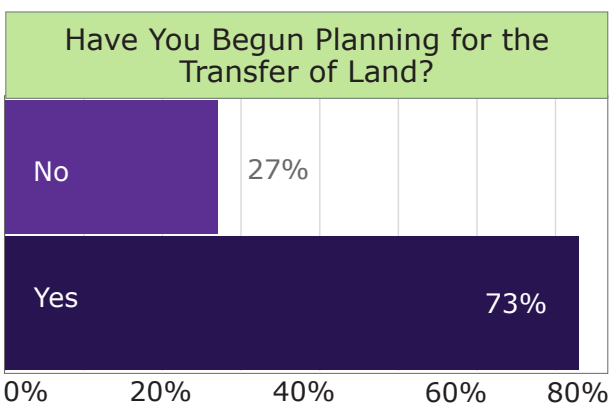
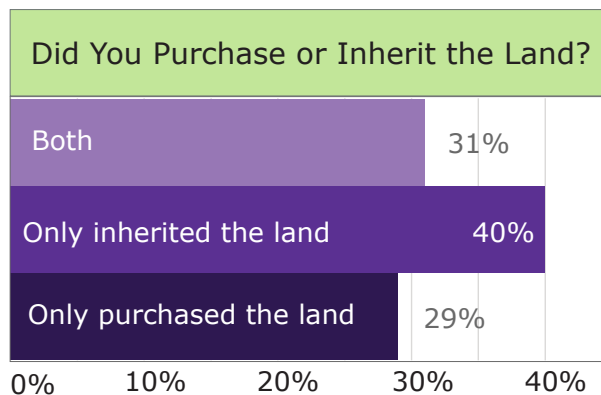
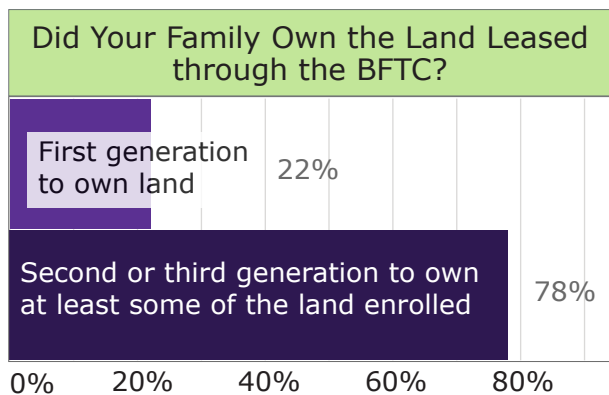
