



Key Sources of Federal Funding

Agricultural Conservation Easement Program-Agricultural Land Easements (ACEP-ALE)

- Provides funds to eligible entities for easements
- \$2.2 billion obligated to protect 2 million acres since 1996

Regional Conservation Partnership Program (RCPP)

- NRCS and partners co-invest in "conservation activities"
- Farmland protection is an allowable conservation activity
- \$760 million awarded; most for practice implementation
